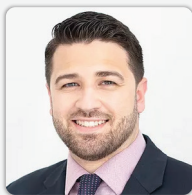

DDS

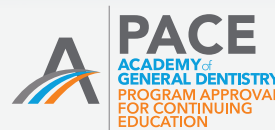
